

## BACHELOR (HONS) IN BIBLICAL AND PASTORAL STUDIES

We outline here the details of the admission requirements for students with qualifications from the UK (or UK-style systems). If you come from a different educational system, please note that the College is a member of the National Academic Recognition Information Centre in the UK ENIC, the UK national agency for international qualifications and skills, and uses its comparisons in reaching decisions on academic admission to the College.

### GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 5 GCSEs grade 9-4 or equivalent (Maths and English subjects are mandatory)
- 2 A-levels, or equivalent OR
- Advanced Diplomas or similar Level Three qualifications, including an Access to Higher Education course

### MATURE STUDENTS (OVER 21)

Applicants aged 21 or over who do not hold standard entry qualifications may still be considered for admission. Decisions will be based on an assessment of relevant qualifications, professional experience, and prior learning, where these are deemed equivalent to the standard entry requirements. Admission is subject to approval by the University of Wales Trinity Saint David.

### ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Non-EU (or EEA) students who intend to study for a degree must demonstrate English language proficiency when applying to study at Newbold College.

ACCEPTED TESTS	English Language Requirements for non-native speakers of English:

International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Academic*	Minimum overall average of 6.0, with a minimum of 6.0 in each skill
Cambridge Certificate: Advanced (CAE)/Cambridge C1 Advanced	Minimum overall score of 169 with no Individual scores below 162
Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE) / Cambridge C2 Proficiency	Minimum overall score of 176
Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)	Minimum overall score of 64, with no individual scores lower than 19

\*IELTS test is the College's recommended test.
